<b>Purpose</b>	<p><b>To Communicate:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Foreign Licenses recognized in the United States.</li> <li>• Foreign Licenses are licenses from other countries. These licenses are valid in the United States if they are issued by countries that have signed the United Nations Convention on Road Traffic, or the Convention on the Regulation of Inter-American Automotive Traffic. Most nations have signed one of these conventions.</li> <li>• Sometimes people holding a Foreign License will also have an International Drivers Permit.</li> <li>• <b>Do Not</b> accept an International Drivers Permit without also seeing the Foreign – issued license. The International Drivers Permit functions only as a legal translation document for the Foreign License.</li> <li>• <i>We are unable to accept a Foreign License if...</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The Foreign License <i>can not</i> be read or translated by <i>our</i> employees <i>AND...</i></li> <li>➤ It is not accompanied with an International Drivers Permit to provide the employees with the Foreign License translation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <i>We will accept a Foreign License if...</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <i>An employee</i> can read the Foreign License in whatever language the license is presented. For example: The license is written in Spanish and the employee can read Spanish <i>OR...</i></li> <li>➤ The license is presented with an International Drivers Permit which provides the employee that does not read Spanish with the English translation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Pay careful attention to the physical characteristics if there is no photo.</li> <li>• All licenses United States or Foreign must still be valid.</li> </ul>
